1 Buying Solutions framework – commences 16 August 2010

Information provided by Buying Solutions

This framework supports the Efficiency and Reform Group's (ERG) aim to centralise procurement for the buying of common goods and services. It will aggregate demand across the public sector to reduce the cost of telecare, telehealth and telecoaching and drive further savings.

The framework agreement is for two years, (with the option of two further one year extensions) and is ready for use from Monday 16th August 2010. Some parts of the web site are currently being uploaded (eg online product catalogue).

It is structured into 6 lots as follows:

Lot 1 – Telecare Products

Lot 2 - Telecare Services

Lot 3 - Telehealth Products

Lot 4 – Telehealth Services

Lot 5 - Telecoaching Products and Services

Lot 6 – Managed Services



3 Education and training for installers of telecare and telehealth technologies - Survey

Provided by Pat Smart at FAST

Foundation for Assistive Technology (FAST) is running a survey to evaluate education and training for installers of telecare and telehealth technologies.

The survey will help us assess how installers are accommodating more complex, integrated sensor and communication systems within their working practice. There is currently no consensus on the training and service planning that is required to deliver an effective installation. This affects not just employers and installer staff but also the commissioners and planners of services.

This issue has been highlighted by one of the Technology Strategy Board's Assisted Living Innovation Platform (ALIP) projects, led by Tynetec, working with Aidcall, Your Homes Newcastle, Darlington Borough Council and Intrahealth.

This learning is to be captured by a short ALIP Knowledge Transfer Network project over the next couple of months involving FAST who are leading on workforce development for the sector, Hereward College and the Tynetec ALIP project team. As a first step, FAST is assessing current installation practice and support for training and education by means of a short online survey of both installers and commissioners of telecare and telehealth systems.

Spending cuts will affect cancer targets, research suggests - The report also shows how the NHS is changing in response to financial pressures: 50 trusts are planning to take on services such as rehabilitation and home visits which are traditionally handled by others.

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
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Having good friends appears to 'boost' survival

"Lead researcher Julianne Holt-Lundstad says there are many ways in which friends, colleagues and family can boost health and wellbeing.

"When someone is connected to a group and feels responsibility for other people, that sense of purpose and meaning translates to taking better care of themselves and taking fewer risks."

In their study, which looked at over 300,000 people from four continents over a period of seven years, those with the strongest social networks fared best in terms of health outcomes and lifespan. They were nearly twice (1.5 times) as likely to be alive at any given age than those who were lonely.

The study included people of all ages and backgrounds, yet the findings remained the same and regardless of initial health status".

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
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
